

Pool Rules

Windsong Community Improvement Association

- 1. All visitors to the pool area agree to abide by the following pool rules. Failure to abide by the rules may result in a resident's temporary or permanent restriction from Association property.
- 2. All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (18 years of age or older).
- 3. Only swimwear attire allowed in the pool, NO EXCEPTIONS
- 4. The following items and activities are prohibited:
 - No glass containers
 - No alcoholic beverages on any community property
 - No smoking in or near the gated area
 - No diapers in the pool except those designed as special swim diapers
 - No food, drinks, or gum in the swimming pool
 - No foul or vulgar language
 - No excessively loud noise
 - No skates, scooters, or skateboards in the gated area
 - No animals in the gated area except officially designated service animals
 - No diving, running, horseplay, fighting, or other dangerous physical activities
 - No toys or sports equipment except small personal floatation devices
 - No removal of Association equipment, furniture or accessories
 - No BBQ pits allowed on premises
- 5. All instructions given by lifeguards must be followed, NO EXCEPTIONS. The Association reserves the right to revoke pool privileges from anyone who causes an unsafe or unpleasant environment at the pool.
- 6. For a serious or life-threatening emergency, call 9-1-1 or use the emergency phone located outside the guard house (on the way to the restrooms).
- 7. Only residents of Windsong, Windsong Place, and their guests have access to use the pool facility. Homeowners with unpaid balances to the Association do not count as "guests" for other residents.
- 8. Residents are permitted up to six (6) guests per household. Residents are responsible for the actions of their children and guests and any damages they may cause. For more than six (6) guests contact our pool manager no less than 24 hours in advance. (see Contact page on windsonginsider.com)
- **9.** The Association and lifeguards are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 10. Lifeguards may call a ten (10) minute break each hour during which all swimmers must exit the swimming pool. Toddlers and their guardians may remain at the baby pool.

Gate access cards may be obtained at the Association's annual "Card Day" event, at any HOA meeting, or at the contracted property management office. Residents receive complimentary cards at first and are responsible for paying a replacement fee to receive additional cards. Homeowners must be in good standing with the Association to receive or activate their gate cards.

To activate new gate cards, residents must complete the required "pool waiver" and "card activation" forms. Links to these forms are located on the pool page at windsonginsider.com.
